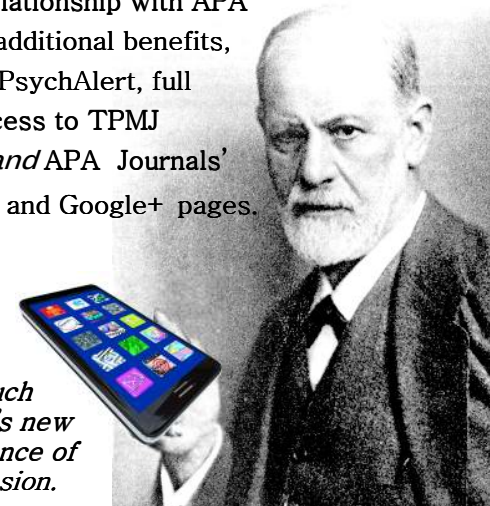
Most conference attendees can satisfy their annual CE requirements through the conference and related institutes.
